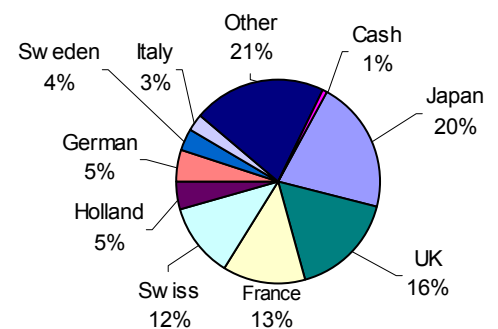

Geographic Distribution



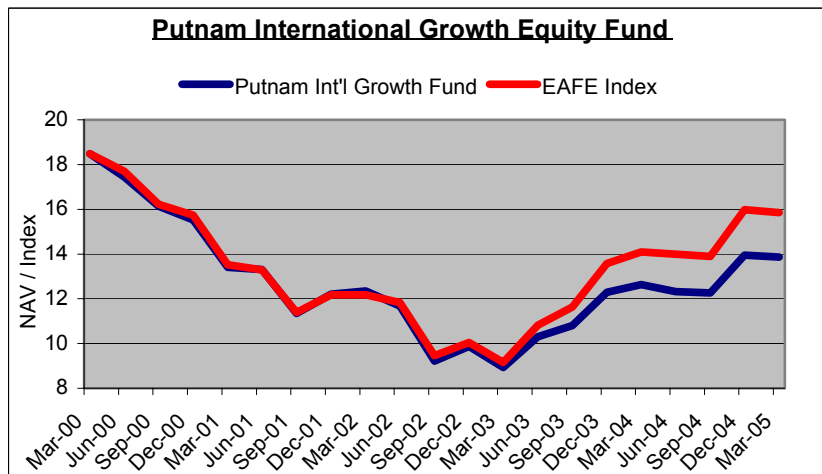
