### Investment Philosophy

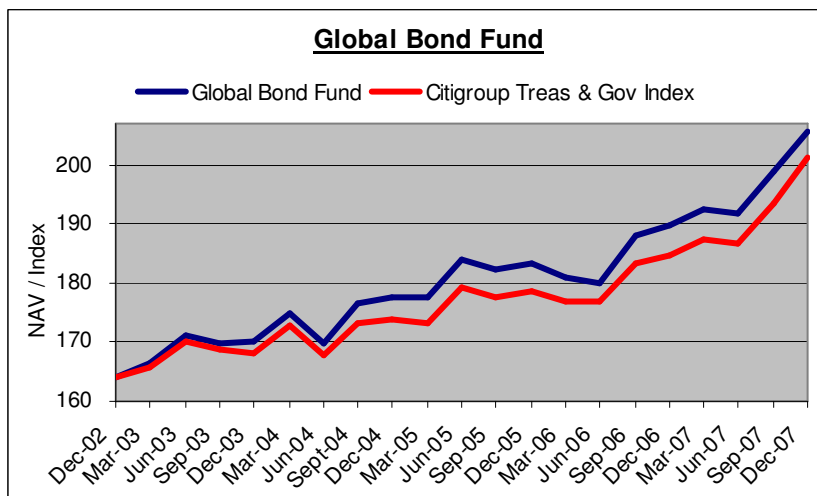
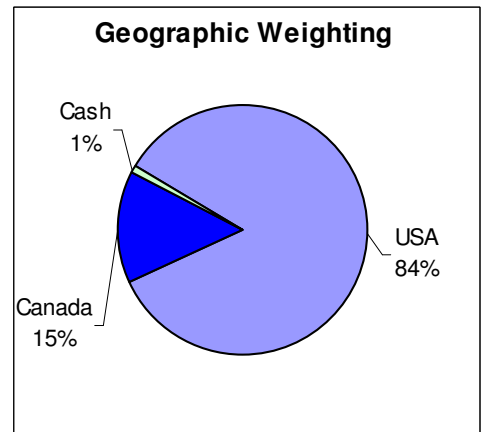

Corporate Bond exposure is limited to a maximum of 20%.
