If only the child is enrolled, are parents expected to use Kurbo? Kurbo is a mobile/online health and weight management program created specifically for children, teens, and their parents. Our program is based on 30 years of research at Stanford University supporting children and teens in achieving their health and weight management goals. Kurbo combines the use of a state-of-the-art mobile app with expert health coaching to help families learn better eating habits, exercise more and take control of their weight to become healthier and more confident.

Kurbo health coaching is available at no cost to all individuals enrolled in a BF&M group or individual health plan, including covered spouses and dependent children, ages 5 and above. They can enroll directly at kurbo.com/BFM. A BF&M group number and certificate number are required.

Any information collected about Kurbo participants is used for Kurbo program purposes only. We have strict protocols to ensure HIPAA compliance and to protect the participant. We conduct background checks on all health coaches and work closely with BF&M to ensure the integrated Kurbo program is safe, secure, and effective for participants of all ages.

The two main components of Kurbo are a mobile app, which includes a food tracker, educational videos and fun games, and a Kurbo Health Coach, who provides feedback, motivation, and support. Participants meet with their coach via FaceTime or Skype weekly and can also contact their coach anytime via in-app messaging. Progress is monitored through an online dashboard.

Kurbo participants learn basic nutrition skills to help them make healthier choices around food and exercise. Topics include portion control, understanding food labels, and the benefits of exercise. Participants also work with their coach to set personal goals around food and exercise to promote long-term lifestyle changes.

Participants generally spend 10 – 15 minutes a day tracking food and exercise, plus weekly 15-minute coaching sessions. The basic program lasts 3 months, but many find coaching helpful for longer periods. BF&M will support a maximum of an additional 3 months. Participants pay the additional fee upfront, and upon completion of the program, will submit their claim to BF&M for reimbursement.

Parent education and involvement is very important to a child's success in Kurbo. In fact, the entire family is encouraged to participate, so everyone in a family gets free access to the Kurbo app when a child is enrolled. Parents also receive a weekly email newsletter and access to an expert parent coach to answer specific questions and concerns.



What if we have only one smartphone? Can the whole family share?

How is Kurbo different?

Kurbo sounds great. How do I convince my child/teen to try it? Families can share one device allowing multiple family members to use Kurbo. Each family member will receive their own login so when one person logs out, the other person can log in and see their personal tracking information and goals.

Kurbo's feature of weekly remote coaching keeps participants motivated and accountable. Kurbo offers a fun mobile app with an easy-to-use food and exercise tracker, and games to keep your child engaged. Kurbo does not teach to count calories as other weight programs do. Instead Kurbo provides simple tools for kids, teens and adults to change their eating habits without feeling deprived. All foods are categorized by nutritional value (e.g. carbs and sugar are reds, veggies, and fruits are greens.) Kurbo has proven to be safe and effective for kids and teens by Stanford's Pediatric Weight Control Program.

We suggest presenting Kurbo to your child as a fun, interactive tool that will help your whole family get healthier. You can suggest it in a way that doesn't single out any one child. Show your child some of the videos on our site so that they can learn about how it works, hear from kids who have experienced success and meet the Kurbo coaches. We often find that if a child is willing to try one coaching call, they are more willing to participate.

If your child is not interested in being coached or too young, we offer a Parent Coaching option wherein you are given the tips and tools to help create a healthy home environment. We know that every family's situation is unique. Please contact Kurbo to talk to one of their expert coaches if you have additional questions.

What devices does Kurbo work on?

Kurbo currently works on Apple devices (iPhone, iPad, iPod Touch) running iOS8 (or newer) and Android devices running Android 4.0 (or newer). Note: Kurbo is constantly working to support popular Apple and Android devices.
